Havana Club 7yo is a full-flavoured, rich and sophisticated Cuban rum with a high degree of elegance and class. A deservedly popular rum.



HAVANA CLUB Selección de Maestros €8.50

A relaunch of Havana Club's Cuban Barrel Proof edition, Selección de Maestros has benefited from an eye-catching packaging upgrade and is bottled at 45% for extra oomph. The Gold Medal-winning liquid inside Havana Club Selección de Maestros remains the same as for the old Cuban Barrel Proof - as the name suggests, the casks have been hand-picked by the maestros roneros from the company's finest aged stocks. The rums selected by the maestros roneros are finished in special casks chosen for their aromatic properties before being bottled at a higher strength than the standard range for a more intense, immediate flavour on the palate.

DINGLE €5.50

A great tasting smooth vodka that is distilled in the Dingle Distillery in County Kerry. One of just a few genuine Irish made vodkas.



GREY GOOSE €8.20

Each batch of Grey Goose vodka begins with soft winter wheat grown on farms in and around the fertile Picardy region of northern France. Grey Goose maître de chai François Thibault insists on using only the highest-grade wheat—the same wheat used in the finest French breads and pastries. After the wheat grain is fermented and distilled into a high-proof spirit, it travels south to Gensac-la-Pallue, in the Cognac arrondissement (region), where it is blended with the remarkably pristine spring water found there.



KETTLE ONE €7.00

Crafted from small batches, Ketel One vodka is a crisp and sophisticated vodka. A Nolet family member approves every batch before it is allowed to leave the distillery.



CRYSTAL HEAD €7.90

Not just a gimmicky, well packaged vodka- this is also very, very good. The unique ingredients are peaches and cream corn which gives a soft and mellow tasting spirit. It is distilled four times and filtered a further seven times (3 of which are done through semi precious crystals).



TITOS €7.00

Tito's Handmade Vodka focuses on the quality of the product. They distill at the same distillery in Austin, Texas, where Tito Beverage started the business in 1995, distilling in batches in pot stills that are customised and hand-built on-site to our proprietary specifications. Hoses and pumps are hand-connected to taste and qualify the next steps with the distillate. Products are made to exacting standards to deliver the highest quality. The artistry involved in knowing when it's time to make those cuts is something that cannot be duplicated by even the most sophisticated machines. Winner of Double Gold in the San Francisco World Spirits Competition.



BELVEDERE €7.90

A Polish vodka made only from Polish Dankowskie Rye and quadruple-distilled for purity.



SKYY €5.50

SKYY in many ways is the classic American dream story, beginning in 1992 as a tiny start up company in San Francisco. It is made with 100% American grains and undergoes quadruple distillation to eliminate any impurities. It is triple filtered using Californian limestone. Today it is the leading domestic premium vodka in the U.S. and this is testament to its' superb smoothness and quality



MAMONT €8.00

Mamont is distilled in the Iktul Distillery in Siberia. It is the only distillery in Russia to produce alcohol from pure malt. Its unique shaped bottle is inspired by the Yukagir Mammoth. The unusual shaped bottle is curved like the tusk! The spirit hails from White Winter Wheat and is 6 times distilled for a smooth finish.

BOMBAY SAPPHIRE €4.70
Bombay Sapphire has a ripe citrus aroma with spice and a touch of juniper. The 10 botanicals are almond, lemon peel, liquorice, juniper berries, orris root, angelica, coriander, cassia bark, cabeb berries & grains of paradise.



TANQUERAY €4.90
Tanqueray London Dry Gin is the original variant of Tanqueray, launched in 1830; the key botanicals are juniper, coriander and angelica root. A high quality gin.



TANQUERAY No. TEN €7.00
Tanqueray No. TEN takes its name from 'Tiny Ten', the nickname of the small copper pot still where every drop is produced, but there is nothing minor about its flavour. The only gin made using whole citrus fruit, including white grapefruit, lime, and orange, along with juniper, coriander, and a hint of chamomile flowers, No. TEN has a unique, full-bodied character and citrus undertone. It is this combination of full body and fresh flavor that has made it a perennial favourite amongst passionate bartenders. Legend has it that Tanqueray was the first drink in the White House after the repeal of prohibition.



GORDAN'S PINK GIN €5.00
Inspired by an original Gordon's recipe from the 1880s, the pink gin has the refreshing taste of Gordon's with the natural sweetness of raspberries and strawberries and a tang of redcurrant. Made using only natural fruit flavours to guarantee the highest quality real berry taste.



SHORTCROSS €6.50
Shortcross is a classical Gin style but with a unique twist, best described as floral meadow, wild berries and grassy notes. It is smooth with an exceptionally long aftertaste and finish. This is achieved through the use of fresh apples, elderberries and wild clover, distilled with other botanicals including juniper, coriander, orange peel, lemon peel and cassia



BLACKWATER No. 5 €6.50
No. 5 is a superb London Dry style gin which is made at the Blackwater Distillery in West Waterford. Each batch is carefully made in small amounts from pure spirit, soft local water and fresh botanicals. This makes an outstanding G&T but also has enough flavour to go into traditional gin based cocktails.



GUNPOWDER €6.50
A hand-crafted gin made in the Shed Distillery, Drumshanbo, Co Leitrim. Oriental Botanicals (berries and roots) and locally foraged Meadowsweet are added to a traditional medieval style still and only allowed to soak for 30 minutes max while the vapour infusion is being prepared. Various oriental fresh citrus and leaves (gunpowder tea) are added into the 3 layer infusion basket, which lies in the vapour pathway between the still and the condenser. Steam is gently applied. The vapour rises through the unique shape of the medieval head, which allows maximum copper contact, which cleans and purifies the spirit. The vapour exits the still and passes into the infusion basket, where it gently extracts the oils and aromas from the citrus and tea. Boiling in the still would extract bitter compounds from these ingredients, whereas vapour infusion only extracts the aromatic oils. The vapour passes into the condenser and is condensed down into our gin at @ 75%. We take an early cut so as to avoid any harshness that tends to come off further into the distillation. The gin is allowed to rest for a week, which allows the oils and alcohol to infuse and for flavour to develop. It is then diluted to 43% with filtered water and gently filtered for clarity.



THE BOTANIST €6.50
This is a truly special gin made in the Bruichladdich distillery on the Scottish island of Islay. 22 of the 31 botanicals are native to Islay, including wild Islay Juniper allowing us to savour a taste of islay that for once has nothing to do with a malt!



DINGLE €5.50
A great gin from the Dingle Distillery. This is very well made and has a classic London dry gin character. Distilled in pot stills with a range of botanicals including Rowan Berry, Fuscia, Bog Myrtle, Heather, Chervil and Hawthorn.



HENDRICKS €6.50
Hendricks is an iconoclastically produced small batch gin distilled in Ayrshire, Scotland. The unusual distillation process combined with the oddly delicious set of infusions yields a one-of-a-kind gin that is passionately loved by a tiny yet growing handful of individuals all over the world. No other gin tastes like it because no other gin is made like it.



MONKEY 47 €8.50
Most people who have tried this would rate it as one of the best gins in the world. Monkey 47 is made from 47 different botanicals and is also bottled at 47%. Smooth, complex and full of flavour.



BEEFEATER 24 €6.50
A more recent addition to the Beefeater range. When creating Beefeater 24, Desmond Payne knew he had to come up with something totally different for his selection of botanicals. He used tea! The 12 ingredients used are Japanese Sencha Tea, Chinese green tea and then Seville orange peel, grapefruit peel, lemon peel, juniper, coriander seed, liquorice, angelica root, almond and orris root. It is called Beefeater 24 because the botanicals are steeped in the spirit for a full 24 hours. The result is a fragrant gin with good sweetness.



KINSALE €6.50
This small batch, premium Irish Gin has been distilled with local botanicals and derives its flavour from the Kinsale country-side. With elegant amounts of juniper, notes of meadowsweet, elderflower combine with aromas of lemon verbena and germanium. Other interesting and unusual botanicals underscore Kinsale Gin's complex personality. Very versatile either in a G&T or your favourite gin based cocktail.



BEEFEATER PINK GIN €5.00
Beefeater master distiller Desmond Payne MBE experimented with several different techniques before he settled on the recipe for this new pretty-in-pink variant, which is made using the original Beefeater London Dry Gin recipe. The strawberry flavour is added post-distillation.



SILVER SPEAR €6.50
Smyth & O'Reilly is a leading Artisan Irish Distillery, specialising in Gin products. The Distillery is based in the historic Ballydarton House, Fenagh, Carlow, Ireland and nestled in the foothills of Mount Leinster. It has a very rich history at its heart. Silver Spear was 14 months in the making and a total of 25 different versions were trialed before the company settled on the final version.

THE KRAKEN €7.00
A dark spiced Caribbean rum introduced to the UK in Spring 2010, Kraken's old-style bottle and superlative packaging seem to earmark it out for greatness, and perhaps it will help some of those many thousands of punters nursing an old-recipe-Sailor-Jerry-sized hole in their hearts.



ANGOSTURA GOLD 5 YEAR OLD €6.50
Great-value Trinidadian gold rum, a blend of light and heavy molasses-based rums aged for five years in charred American oak bourbon barrels.



MOUNT GAY €5.50
Mount Gay Eclipse is a very popular golden rum that makes a great Mojito. This rum is produced from molasses that is double distilled and aged up to 2 years in white Kentucky oak ex bourbon barrels
