

 **TEELING SMALL BATCH** €5.50
A first release of Irish Whiskey for the Teeling Whiskey Company. This is a blend of Irish grain and malt whiskeys that have been married in rum casks before bottling at 46%.

 **TEELING SINGLE MALT** €7.50
A great single malt that is drawn from various ages of whisky from a single undisclosed Irish distillery. The oldest malt in this dates back to 1991 and the various components have been matured in different types of barrels including Sherry, Port, Madeira, White Burgundy and Cabernet Sauvignon. Possibly our favourite new whiskey of 2014. At this price it represents great value for money. Never mind that there is not an age statement, this is as good, if not better than most 12 year old single malts.

 **THE IRISHMAN FOUNDERS RESERVE** €5.90
Triple distilled for a smoother taste, this vatting of single pot still and single malt whiskey is matured and aged to perfection in bourbon infused barrels. Fragrant notes of green apple and honey give way to pot still spice and summer fruits with a deep finish fading into spiced oak and butterscotch.

 **THE IRISHMAN CASK STRENGTH 54%** €16.50
A rare cask strength expression matured and aged in personally selected oak bourbon casks to showcase the summit of Irish Whiskey. This special release is complex and intriguing. Elegant aromas of fruit and ginger, give way to creamy oak and spice with a complexity that balances its considerable strength.

 **CONNEMARA PEATED SINGLE MALT** €5.60
Connemara is rare amongst Irish whiskey, its hook being the smokiness associated with the malts produced by our neighbours Scotland. It's a style of whiskey that had died away in Ireland after the 19th century, when small distillers would probably have dried their malt with whatever fuel was available at the time. It's said that when the Cooley Distillery started up in the late 1980s, it had no plans to make a smoky whiskey, but at some stage peaty malt was bought and run through the stills with fantastic results. It's a lovely malty whiskey with Cooley's signature honey and pear notes as well as a beautiful waft of smoke. Since it was released in the late 1990s, it has won over many fans of peated Scotch whiskies such as Laphroaig and Ardbeg. Yet Connemara still has a definite Irish character.

 **KILBEGGAN 8 YEAR OLD** €6.30
A unique single grain Irish Whiskey. Sweet and smooth this delicate whiskey is produced in small batches to the highest possible quality for your ultimate enjoyment.

 **WEST CORK BLACK CASK** €5.50
This blend from West Cork has gone through some clever finishing in highly charred bourbon barrels. Each barrel is double charred to 'level 5' which delivers enhanced vanilla flavours, sweetness and smoothness to the whiskey.

 **WEST CORK 12 YEAR OLD RUM CASK** €6.50
A fruity, delicate and light single malt that has been finished in the finest rum casks from the West Indies.

 **WEST CORK 10 YEAR OLD SINGLE MALT** €5.90
This single malt is hand crafted using the finest hand selected ingredients and patiently matured in bourbon casks for 10 years to deliver a very special and rare Irish Whiskey. Its outstanding quality promises to deliver a truly special drinking experience cherished by all.

 **WEST CORK BOURBON CASK** €5.50
This Bourbon Cask is a classic blend Irish Whiskey containing the finest grain and malt Irish Whiskey. Hand crafted using hand selected ingredients and matured in bourbon casks to deliver the authentic and unique quality.

 **DINGLE SINGLE MALT** €8.50
This single malt has been created by the marriage of meticulously selected casks, both Port and Bourbon. This single malt Irish whiskey is a small piece of history, unique and rare. The marriage of the Port and Bourbon casks has resulted in an exceptional single malt, which balances notes of dark fruits, citrus, chocolate and spice. The texture is creamy up front but the finish is deliciously crisp and fresh.



Herbs and spicy flavour are complemented by a touch of cedar wood for extra complexity.</i>

This is now the standard expression of this much loved single malt and has apparently been tweaked slightly with a selection of ex-Bourbon barrel matured making up the entire vatting. It is as soft and elegant as ever but perhaps slightly more mature tasting than the previous 40% bottling.</i>

Proof that ex-bourbon casks can really help bring out distillery character without overwhelming the charm of the pure spirit.</i>

This has a rich, but smooth texture with flavours of caramel toffee, dried fruits and citrus peel. One of the more full-flavoured whiskeys from this distillery.</i>
